

Harley's Home Boarding for Dogs

Daily Routine

The following routine is guided, the routine needs to be adapted for each dog dependent on their age and physical ability

Toileting in the garden

Morning meal – 7am to allow plenty of time for food to digest before the morning exercise

Toileting

Mid-morning:

Exercise – Walk off-site with resident dog of between 45 and 60 minutes dependent on fitness and age of dog (on or off lead as agreed with owner)

Quiet Time

Play period (inside or outside weather dependent)

Afternoon

Play/Socialisation – participating in activities individually or with resident dog and dependent on fitness and age. Consented activities include: snuffle mats with healthy treats, ball games, hide and seek with toys (scent work), Frisbee, toys, licky mats and basic agility

Toileting (if play has taken place inside)

Exercise – Walk off-site with resident dog of between 30 and 60 minutes dependent on fitness and age of dog (on or off lead as agreed with owner)

Daily grooming and health check followed by rest period

Play period (optional dependent on how the dog is)
